ASSOCIATION CERTIFICATION AGREEMENT

DEFINITION OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT EXPLORING ASSOCIATION:

A Law Enforcement Explorer Association is defined as any group, using the name or any part of Learning for Life, Law Enforcement Exploring, or any of its proprietary assets that has organized itself for the purpose of sponsoring meetings, training, competition or other activities for Law Enforcement Explorers, Advisors, adult leaders and others.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT EXPLORING ASSOCIATIONS:

1. Each association must have a written mission statement, constitution and/or by-laws that clearly identify the association's purpose, function, administrative structure and membership requirements. This document must not contain any provisions that are inconsistent with Learning for Life/Law Enforcement Exploring policies and procedures.
2. Certification criteria for the association must include a requirement for adult registration with the Learning for Life/Law Enforcement Exploring Program as an adult leader. Further, membership may not be restricted on the basis of gender, race, religion, creed or political persuasion.
3. One professional Learning for Life staff member from the Learning for Life office that serves the jurisdiction in which the association has its official address must be permitted to serve without fee as a full member of the association.
4. Each association must comply with Learning for Life/Law Enforcement Exploring policies and procedures that govern activities, travel, fund raising, and incorporating using proprietary assets of Learning for Life/Law Enforcement Exploring.
5. Each association must notify and involve the appropriate Learning for Life local office(s) when any activity or event involves multiple Learning for Life jurisdictions.
6. Avoid activity dates that conflict with the National Law Enforcement Exploring Conference.

FULFILLING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION BY THE NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT EXPLORING COMMITTEE PROVIDES:

1. Formal recognition of the association as well as a forum for the exchange of program information.
2. Additional resources offered through local Learning for Life offices.
3. Designation of adult participants as Learning for Life volunteers which provides recourses that protect the volunteers and their association.

PROCESS FOR CERTIFICATION:

1. Review and comply with the above requirements.
